

## Art Appreciation Programme

April to June 2019

**Our Meetings are usually held on the fourth Tuesday of the month unless we have to change the day for gallery closure or other reasons.**

### Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> April (fifth Tuesday because of Easter)

Visit to National Gallery to see exhibition of the Spanish Impressionist **'Sorolla: Spanish Master of Light'**. Rare opportunity to see the most complete exhibition of Sorolla's paintings outside Spain.

### Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> May (2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday because of Spring Bank Holiday)

Visit to Gainsborough's House Museum at Sudbury for an hour long guided tour of Gainsborough's House at 2 p.m. as well as a visit to see **'Heads and Hands'** an exhibition of sculptural portraits by Nicole Farhi, a sculptor and former fashion designer.

### Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> June (3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday – not open on a Tuesday and holiday)

Visit to Alfred Munnings House at Dedham for a special exhibition **'Behind the Lines: Alfred Munnings, War Artist, 1918'**. 41 of Munnings' paintings as a war artist have been lent by the Canadian War Museum, in Ottawa. They were previously on show at the National Army Museum in Chelsea.

When we travel to London, we usually catch the first Cheap Day (9.27 Chelmsford, 9.32 Ingatestone) and liaise at the barrier of Platform 11 at Liverpool Street. We normally travel on by bus to the Galleries though, depending on the location, we sometimes use the Underground (for Tate Britain)

For those who do not have transport, I will do my best to arrange lifts for local visits.
