On **Wednesday** 24th October (the gallery is not open on a Tuesday), we are going to the William Morris Gallery in Walthamstow to see the exhibition '**The Enchanted Garden**', which explores how Morris's contemporaries and subsequent generations of artists - from the Pre-Raphaelites to the Bloomsbury Group - responded to the allure of garden spaces.

Featured artists include Claude Monet, Lucian Pissarro, Stanley Spencer, Roger Fry, Vanessa Bell, Beatrix Potter etc. and there are loans from across the UK. The exhibition is organised by the Laing Art Gallery in association with the William Morris Gallery. Entrance is free. We shall meet there at 2 p.m.
