On Tuesday 26th March we shall travel to Tate Modern to see the Pierre Bonnard Exhibition 'The Colour of Memory'. Born in 1867, he was one of the greatest colourists of the early 20th century. He preferred to work from memory, recalling scenes he had seen and making colour his dominant concern. It should be an enjoyable and interesting exhibition.

We will catch the first Cheap Day train (Chelmsford 9.27, Ingatestone 9.32) and liaise at the barrier of Platform 11 at Liverpool Street at about 10.05., From there, we can take the number 11 bus alighting at St Paul's and crossing the Thames to Tate Modern on the Millennium Bridge.
