**THE GARDEN MUSEUM and TATE MODERN**

**The Garden Museum** was the inspiration of Rosemary Nicholson and opened in 1977. It sits inside the building of the Church of St. Mary’s-At-Lambeth, a beautiful setting. The John Tradescants, both father and son were plant hunters in the 17<sup>th</sup> century, and are buried here. The museum is unique in being the only one in Britain tere feature history, art and design of gardens plus offering the challenge of climbing the medieval tower’s 131 steps!

The museum has a number of permanent exhibitions on two floors (lift possible) plus at the time of our visit two temporary exhibitions: Kiftsgate Court Gardens, 100 years of Women Gardeners and Ivon Hitchens, Painter in the Woods. Our visit will be self-guided.

The Museum also has a café but seating is limited so for lunch, it may be easier for us to re-board our coach and make our way to the Tate Modern next to the Millenium Bridge.

**Tate Modern** has several free exhibitions at the time of our visit plus a large café on the top floor. Exhibitions are, as always, challenging and include surrealism and magic realism – art in Weimar Germany 1919-33. Marc Chagall’s The Green Donkey is available to view plus there are a number of other exhibitions (see website).

If the Tate Modern is not your thing the Millennium Bridge is a few steps away with easy access to St. Paul’s Cathedral and Paternoster Square – so much to see and places to eat.
